1.0 Purpose

To ensure all students of Hume Anglican Grammar are wearing the correct school uniform items and that the manner in which these items are worn meets the School's expectations.

2.0 Scope

This Uniform Policy applies to all students of the School, both Primary and Secondary.

4.0 Desired Outcomes

Develop students with school pride, who can embark on meaningful and productive lives as confident and respected global citizens. To provide parents and students with a comprehensive set of guidelines related to the uniform so it is always worn correctly and is clean, in good repair and of a good fit in accordance with the expectations of this policy.

5.0 Rationale

School uniform is compulsory for students attending Hume Anglican Grammar. This is a policy matter that parents and students agree to support by virtue of enrolment at the School.

A properly worn uniform:

- Will enhance the School image and student pride in the School.
- Is an indicator of a positive school tone.
- Is a means of student identification with the School community.
- Provides a strong representation of the School at inter-school and broader community events.
- Allows the wider community to identify our students.
- Diminishes clothing costs, fashion competitiveness and superficial individual differences.
- Provides one avenue through which students may learn respect for societal norms.
- Teaches students to be well presented and respectful of the School's expectations.

At Hume Anglican Grammar students are required to wear the uniform which is easy to wear, inexpensive, and reflects the values of the School. The uniform is only available for purchase through the schools authorised provider, currently *Noone's Imagewear*

6.0 Definitions

Academic: refers to the regular uniform worn during normal school hours and does not include the wearing of any items associated with the sports uniform.

Sports Uniform: non-academic uniform worn only for participation in practical Physical Education classes, practical Performing Arts classes or internal and external sporting events.

Uniform Violation: the incorrect wearing of the uniform resulting in disciplinary action which may in some cases be the removal from class and parent contact to rectify the non-compliance issue.

Established and Recognised Legitimate part of Religious Practice: refers to items of attire that form a theological basis or religious practice authorised by recognised religious authorities.

7.0 Uniform Items

The following is an alphabetised list of uniform items. It must be read in conjunction with the appendices document.

Accessories

- Only approved items carrying the Hume Grammar logo are permitted to be worn as accessories, including scarves and hats.

Bags

- Only official Hume Grammar bags with the registered and official crest and logo are permitted at school.

Blazers

- Blazers must be worn to and from school in Terms 2 and 3 by all students in Years 6 to 12.
- All students in Year 6-12 are required to wear their blazer for Chapel Service, Assemblies, and excursions throughout the year or as otherwise required.
- All blazers must be smart and provide a positive appearance, students are encouraged to wear their blazer where possible.
- Blazer sleeves are not to be rolled up.
- Students are not required to wear their blazer to school in Term 1 and 4, but must always have access to their blazer for:
 - Assemblies
 - Chapel
 - Photos
 - Special Events Nominated
 - Excursions

Boys Facial Hair

- Boys must be clean shaven unless facial hair is an established and recognised legitimate part of religious practice

Concealer/Foundation

- Students are not allowed to wear foundation or concealer.

Cosmetics

- Students are not permitted to wear any form of cosmetics (including all forms of make-up) to school.
- Student found wearing any form of cosmetics will be required to remove it immediately.
- Any student who refuses to remove the cosmetics will be in violation of this policy and this may result in disciplinary action.

Earrings

- Ear jewellery may be round 3mm piercing-style studs (plain diamante optional) or traditional 10-12mm sleepers no more than 1mm thick only (no designs, hoops, stretchers or large solitaires). These must be unobtrusive in nature.
- Not more than two items may be worn in each ear lobe and not in any other part of the ear. Ear jewellery must be removed for safety reasons as required.
- Students are not permitted to wear nose rings to school.

Eye Make Up

- Students are not allowed to wear any form of eye make-up

False Eyelashes

- Students are not allowed to wear false eyelashes or have lash extensions.

Gloves

- Gloves are not part of the school uniform. If students decide to wear gloves they must be plain and dark navy in colour.

Grooming

- All students are expected to attend school neatly groomed with clean, neat and tidy hair and uniform.

Hair

- All student must wear their hair off their face at all times.

Hair Length (Boys and Girls)

- Hair length should be above the shoulders and not longer than the bottom of their shirt collar/dress otherwise they will need to tie their hair up.
- Nothing shorter than a number 2 clipper is permitted. Hair should be the natural colour and not multi-coloured. This includes braiding should this exist.

Hair Ties

- Black hair ties are permissible.
- Navy and maroon hair ties are permissible.

Hairstyles

- Students must avoid extremes in hair style and colouring that conflict with the rationale of this policy. Extremes of hairstyle or styles that attract attention are not permitted. This includes Mohawks, patterning and dramatic changes in hair length.

Headwear

- The turban, patka, or headscarf colour must conform to the standards applied to all headwear. They must be maroon (matching the school jumper) or navy blue only.

Jewellery

- Students are not permitted to wear jewellery unless it conforms to the conditions outlined under each specified item listed in this policy
- Any other visible jewellery or other adornments will be confiscated for a period of time and returned at the School's discretion.

Leggings

- The Dance uniform, which includes leggings, is to only be worn by Secondary students studying Dance.
- Leggings are not to be worn by any other student, unless a particular exemption has been granted.

Lipstick

- Students are not allowed to wear lipstick.

Nail Polish

- Students are not allowed to wear nail polish.

Neckwear

- Students are not permitted to wear neckwear that is visible.

Piercings

- No jewellery, or other material, is to be worn in body pierced areas other than the ears – (Nose, tongue, lip or facial studs are strictly forbidden).

Rain Jackets

- Rain jacket can be worn over the blazer to and from school in Terms 2 and 3 only in inclement weather.
- Rain jackets can only be worn in Term 1 and 4 if it is raining before or after school.
- Rain Jackets are not to be worn during class time.
- Rain Jackets are not to be worn at assemblies or official gatherings unless otherwise advised.

Sock Height

- All socks, sport and school, must cover the ankle. Types described as 'no show', 'low cut' or 'shoe sock' are not permitted.

Sport Socks

- Sport socks for both boys and girls must be plain white without any branding, colours or logos.

Socks (Girls)

- Girls are to wear only white school socks (the white sock with the school blue and red band is permitted) in summer and the blue long socks or tights in winter.
- Black socks are forbidden.

Socks (Boys)

- Boys are required to wear the dark grey school sock only (the grey sock with school blue and red band is permitted).
- Black socks are forbidden.

Shoes

- All students are required to wear black school leather shoes only.

Shoes (Girls)

- Girls are able to wear either black school leather shoes either with laces or the T-bar style.

Shoes (Boys P-2)

- Boys in P-2 may wear Velcro-style black school shoes.

Shoes (Boys 3-12)

- Black school shoes with black laces are required for all boys from Years 3-12

Sports Uniform

- Hume Anglican Grammar has a sports uniform and students can wear this all day when they have a practical PE lesson.
- For theory lessons, students must wear the regular academic school uniform.
- Students must wear their academic school uniform and change into their PE uniform if they do not have a practical PE class during the day and have inter-school sports training after school.

Sports Uniform is not be worn when:

- A student required to be on stage at an assembly or other special event must do so in their regular academic school uniform and change into their PE uniform afterward.

Sport Uniform (Variation to Standards)

- Any variations of these standards on the basis of religious or cultural grounds (such as the wearing of a turban (Maroon or Navy, matching the school colours shown on the school crest), wearing a hijab (Maroon or Navy), and application of henna may be approved in consultation between parents, the Assistant Principal and the Principal or their delegate within an essential agreement of "no visible items of adornment.

Storage

- Care is to be taken in the storage of uniform items in bags and lockers, blazers need to be hung up.

Tattoos

- Normal uniform items must cover any tattoos in the unlikely event that they have been applied.

Wristwatches

- Students are invited to wear wristwatches, but of an unobtrusive design.

6. Communication

Appendix A - Secondary Girls

Summer

Compulsory

- Summer dress (7-12)
- **OR**
- Navy skirt (optional Years 10-12) with Blue pin-striped shirt (Optional Years 10-12)
- **OR**
- Summer Shorts with White blouse
- White socks
- School pullover
- Black, flat, leather lace up, single bar or T-bar school shoes (non-runner style)
- School Backpack (Navy with logo)

Optional

- School blazer (unless required)
- School hat or school cap with logo – compulsory for PE lessons outside

Winter

- Winter skirt
- **OR**
- charcoal grey trousers
- Long sleeved white shirt with logo
- School pullover
- School blazer
- School tie
- Ink navy tights or dark navy socks
- Black, flat, leather lace up, single bar or T-bar school shoes (non-runner style)
- School Backpack (Navy with logo)

Optional

- Rain jacket (optional but must be standard Hume Grammar rain jacket with logo)
- School scarf (optional but must have school logo)
- School beanie (optional but must have school logo)
- Note: girls are able to wear long sleeved pants all year round

- Dark grey long shorts
- Short sleeve white shirt with logo
- Dark grey socks
- School jumper
- Black, leather lace up school shoes (non-runner style)
- School Backpack (Navy with logo)

Optional

- School hat or school cap with logo – compulsory for PE lessons outside
- Note: boys are permitted to wear long pants all year round
- School blazer (unless required)

Winter

Compulsory

- Dark grey trousers
- Long sleeve white shirt with logo
- School tie
- Dark grey socks
- School jumper
- School blazer
- Black, leather lace up school shoes (non-runner style)
- School Backpack (Navy with logo)

Optional

- Rain jacket (optional but must have school logo)
- School scarf (optional but must have school logo)
- School beanie (optional but must have school logo)
